I was honoured to attend the launch of the Kenya Youth Employment and Entrepreneurship Accelerator Program (K-YEEAP) and Call to Action on the drought situation in Kenya by @KEPSA_KENYA held at the Villa Rosa Kempinski on 31/10/2022. During this forum, I had an opportunity to request the 1.7 million registered companies in Kenya to absorb into their organizations, our youth as management trainees or interns.

FOUNDATION DONATES FOOD IN KAJIADO Purko, Kumpa Community Benefit

On the 13th of October 2022, the Optiven Foundation took sometime to join Humanitarian and Corporate organizations to support famine victims in Kajiado. The organizations lead by the County Government of Kajiado are operating in the County to donate relief food support to hunger-stricken residents at the grassroot levels. The relief food and livestock pellets were received by Governor Joseph Ole Lenku and County Commissioner, Harun Kamau, who are Co-chairs of the County Drought Risk Coordination Committee as well as organisation representatives including Mr. George Wachiuri, in his capacity as Chairman of the Optiven Foundation.

The initiative under the National Drought Management Authority (NDMA) partnered with Optiven Foundation, which is the soft arm of Optiven Group, Kenya's leading Real East Company that participated in the drive. NDMA's support includes 5,600 bags of livestock feed pellets, 2,000 litres of fuel subsidy for ten community boreholes and 150,000 litres of water for 30 schools and Optiven Foundation on the other hand donated relief food for 450 households in Purko and Kumpa Wards, Kajiado Central.



The gesture came only a day after Governor Joseph Ole Lenku and the County Commissioner formed a Central Joint Committee to receive all relief food support for the County. The Optiven Foundation has in this quarter provided key support to victims of the ongoing famine through donation of food parcels in Kajiado and Machakos counties.
