

OPTIVEN INSPIRES DIASPORA INVESTORS | Investors Receive Title Deeds On 4 Continents













opportunity to bring on board partners for the support and donatins to the less fortunate. The caravan begun on the 14th of December 2023.








OPTIVEN FOUNDATION BENEFITS FROM BOOK SALES | A Review of After the Plunge
