OPTIVEN FOUNDATION HANDS OVER LAB | Makobeni School, Viriko, Benefits...

14th of May 2025 marked the beginning of grand transformation in the education and affairs of at Makobeni studies Secondary School. Celebrations to mark the official handover of at state-of-the-art modern laboratory rung in the air as students, parents, teachers, local leaders and representatives from the **Optiven Foundation joined** in the revelries. This was the result of a journey that begun in March of 2024 when the Directors and



Chairman of the Optiven Foundation begun the construction of the laboratory with a ground breaking and prayer ceremony at the school. Located in the precincts of Malindi outskirts, Makobeni Secondary School is home to 150 students – 100 young men and 50 young ladies. Why was this school selected to benefit with the fully funded donation of a laboratory by the Optiven Foundation? We spoke to members of the Administration team who noted that the school which has only 8 staff also has a big shortage of classrooms and a staffroom. Teachers at the school work mainly on voluntary basis as majority of the students come from challenged backgrounds where their guardians or parents as the case may be are unable to pay their tuition fees. The students are fed by well wishers while the government chips in to support. Before Optiven built the laboratory, the students were housed in one building that was built by the national government county development fund. As for the teachers, their staff room is under a tree near the single building in the school. For Optiven Foundation to have come on board, it means the laboratory would save the students over 100 miles travels to the nearest secondary school with a laboratory. And here it would be an opportunity for the students of Makobeni Secondary School, to see, to touch and experiment with laboratory apparatus, some for the first time and this first time is when doing their examinations.

We leave the administration's views for a while to understand why Optiven Foundation donated the laboratory. The project was done under the Optiven Foundation's pillar of Education. This pillar also hosts the Soaring Eagles Scholarship Program, the TVET Support initiatives, The Management Trainees Mentorship Program and the George Wachiuri School of Mentorship. Through support from investors in real estate, the Optiven Foundation was able to build the laboratory from scratch at a cost of 10.5 million shillings. The engagement not only benefitted the students but locals involved in the construction work were able to improve their lives under the Poverty Eradication pillar of the Optiven Foundation.

Someone once said, "the greatness of a community is most accurately measured by the compassionate actions of its members". And this was the clarion call by Dr. George Wachiuri, Chairman of the Optiven Foundation who while appreciating the Optiven customers for investing, also called on the professionals from the Makobeni area to go back home and help develop the area. As the sun dawned to shine it's glory on the celebrations, the day's joy was capped with donations of food, sanitary pads and footballs to benefit the family of Makobeni Secondary School. This May 2025, we meet John N. Kimani, a Building and Construction Officer who has been involved with the project sponsored by Optiven at Makobeni Secondary School in Viriko area of Kilifi County. He towers from his stature among those witnessing the official handover of the modern laboratory, the first of it's kind in Viriko and which is touted to be the game changer in education in the area. For him, this has been a journey of close to two years not just of construction but learning, observing and finally being an agent of transformation. The Optiven Point took a moment to peek at his journey.

Based on your engagement during the construction of the Makobeni Secondary School Laboratory, what would you say were some of your challenges? The area is in a remote and under developed location where the community dynamics in terms of culture, work ethic, and general lifestyle paused a myriad obstacles. Accessing the site owing to the poor transport



infrastructure and a lack of exposure for the workers meant more energy in making this a reality. Overally, the social economic status of the community and their world view caused unforeseen delays in delivery of the completed laboratory.

Seeing the duration it took to complete the project, were there any tangible lessons you learnt personally? Without restraining the community, the area is in dire need of continuous support from well wishers. A number of factors including cultural, environmental, and a lack of exposure on sustainable green living have contributed to the status quo. But all said and done, all help, from any stakeholder, will go a long way in transforming lives in Makobeni.

Any parting shot on your part?

Thinking of my experiences, I can conclude that both sunrise and sunset bring opportunities, one to dream, and the other to do. And indeed, a great parting shot for the champion of transformation, congratulations.

MENTAL HEALTH MONTH | Optiven Brings Value to Staff boosting Mental Health

It is May and it is also the World Mental Health Month. How Can Corporates Bring Value to their Staff? We consider what approach Optiven has taken. Presently, there is a cultural shift toward greater mental health awareness. This is key to focusing on psychological suffering, improving access to mental health resources, and reducing stigma in the corporate space. The Big Q to Martin Waweru, Associate Director for Human Resources and Talent Acquisition at Optiven Group, then becomes how has Optiven supported it's staffs' mental health without encouraging them to dwell on their negative thoughts and feelings?

"Corporates are increasingly focused on the mental health needs of their workers, and for good reason. With a consistent increase in anxiety and depression, especially among young adults, this becomes a matter of policy.

It's good for corporates to be aware of their employees' mental health concerns. The more organizational leaders and managers appreciate mental health problems among workers and the fact that these problems decrease work engagement, job performance, and retention — the more motivated the

staff will be to create an organizational culture that promotes good mental health.

How can corporates support workers' mental health without encouraging them to dwell on their negative thoughts and feelings?

ATTENTION ORIENTATION : Corporates should take advantage of evidence-based strategies for reducing anxiety and depression symptoms. These can bolster mental health-protective psychological states that don't encourage a fixation on one's own negative thoughts and emotions.





